

Team Vitality Donations Terms and Conditions

1. The Organiser of the initiative is Discovery Vitality (Pty) Ltd ("Vitality").
2. The Team Vitality Donation initiative will only be available for (4) four weeks on the Vitality Mall platform. The donation values will be redeemable in the Vitality Mall during the period of 16 September 2026 – 15 October 2026.
3. Under the initiative, participants will have access to various donation values which they may select, which will go towards providing support to Elizabeth "Tsontso" Moselakgomo's family and her daughter ("the recipient") in respect of financial support for her future. Participants may not select more than one donation value at the same time, in one given transaction. Participants may however make multiple donations, subject to having sufficient Discovery Miles available.
4. Based on the number of donations selected by participants, clause 9 of these Terms and Conditions shall apply.
5. The donation made by each participant will be directed towards providing support to the recipient's family and financial support for the recipient. Discovery Vitality (Pty) Limited is not a charitable organization.

8. The Organiser will take reasonable steps to ensure that all funds received shall be used for the intended purpose of this initiative.

The Organiser will hold all donations received in respect of this initiative until such time as an appropriate and duly authorised designated recipient structure or and/or beneficiary arrangement for the receipt of funds has been identified and made available. Furthermore, once the designated recipient structure or and/or

beneficiary arrangement has been confirmed, the funds will be directed to the intended purpose of this initiative.

Once the funds have been transferred by Discovery Vitality, the administration, management and use of the funds will be the responsibility of the authorised designated recipient structure and/or beneficiary arrangement, the Organiser will not be liable for any decisions or actions relating to the use of the funds thereafter.
11. Participants of this initiative will not be entitled to a tax certificate in terms of section 18(A) of the Income Tax Act 58 of 1962 for their donation as Discovery Vitality is not a public benefit organisation.
